COMMUNITY

The Kenston Local School District encompasses the townships of Auburn and Bainbridge and is adjacent to Chagrin Falls. The system is located in a residential community with an above average income, twenty-five miles east of downtown Cleveland. Approximate population is 13,000. The 1992-93 school year begins Kenston's 40th year

SCHOOL

Kenston High School is a public four year comprehensive high school with a population of 725 students. The school is accredited by the North Central Association and the State of Ohio.

FACULTY

The Kenston High School faculty and administration number 60 with 60% having earned advanced degrees. The average teaching experience is 17 years.

CURRICULUM

A variety of honors, college preparatory and skill level courses are available in academic and vocational disciplines. Individual and small group instruction laboratories are offered in the writing and mathematics areas. The following Advanced Placement (AP) courses are available for juniors and seniors:

- AP English III - Junior
- AP English IV - Senior
- AP American History - Junior
- AP European History - Senior
- AP Calculus - Senior
- AP Spanish - Senior
- AP French - Senior

In 1992, fifty-one students took AP exams. Kenston had three National Merit Finalists and six National Merit Commended students.
