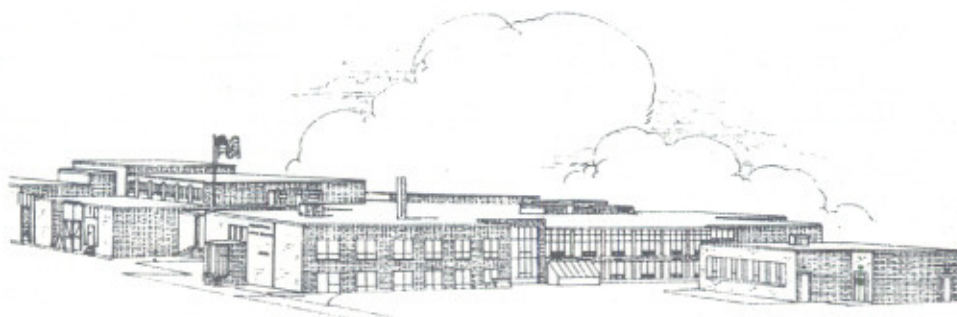

## CURRICULUM

## SAT 1995: 84 Tested

The Scholastic Aptitude Test is taken in the junior and senior years. The test provides verbal and math aptitude scores. The test scale is 200-800.
