BE IT RESOLVED, by the board of education of the Kenston Local School District that the auditor of Geauga County be and is hereby requested to draw his warrants and the treasurer of said county be and is hereby requested to pay to the treasurer of this board, from time to time on the request of the treasurer of this board, any money in the county treasury to the account of this board and lawfully applicable to the purpose of the first half real property tax settlement of the fiscal year 2013. Section 2. This resolution shall be in full force and effect and authority contained herein shall be effective upon the execution hereof and shall continue until further notice.

Section 3. The treasurer of this board of education shall forward a certified copy of this resolution to Huntington National Bank and Geauga County treasurer upon the passage thereof.
