e. RESOLUTION – Teaching Financial Literacy and College and Career Readiness

WHEREAS the Kenston Board of Education believes in and supports the importance of teaching financial literacy and college and career readiness:

AND

WHEREAS the Kenston Board of Education believes that preparing students for post secondary education, equipping them with the prerequisite skills needed for a successful career, and teaching students to become financially literate, including the ability to read, analyze, manage and communicate about the personal financial conditions that affect material well-being, will position them for success in later life.

THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Kenston Board of Education supports and believes strongly in the importance of teaching financial literacy and college and career readiness in both the middle grades (7 and/or 8) and in the high school.

f. Membership in Ohio High School Athletic Association for 2011-2012
