Kenston Academic Academy is open to all students who need help completing daily assignments, catching up on absence work or assistance with organizational skills. Parents may sign up their child or students may be referred to KAA by teacher recommendation. A parent(s) signature is necessary on the KAA referral form, which should be returned to the student’s appropriate guidance counselor.

*Parents can pick up students at the KMS main entrance at 3:15 P.M. Other transportation is not available.

*Students are assisted by teacher proctors. KAA is not an intensive one on one tutoring session. Students are expected to bring work to KAA and will be assisted as needed. Students will sign-in each time they attend and will note a goal plan for work completion for that particular day.

*Students are not required to attend every week or each day KAA is offered; parents should arrange a schedule with their child based on need. Once they are registered, students are eligible to attend KAA for the entire year.

KAA STUDENT EXPECTATIONS

- Students must attend for the full amount of time (2:30pm – 3:15pm)
- Students can leave early only with a written note from their parent(s)
- While students are at KAA they must work quietly and diligently and utilize their time to complete homework or other academic assignments
- While at KAA, students should not be using cell phones for talking or texting. Cell phones may be used for academic purposes with permission of the KAA teacher proctors. If a student needs to call for a ride, this should be should done prior to the start of KAA.
- Students must have transportation set up in advance
