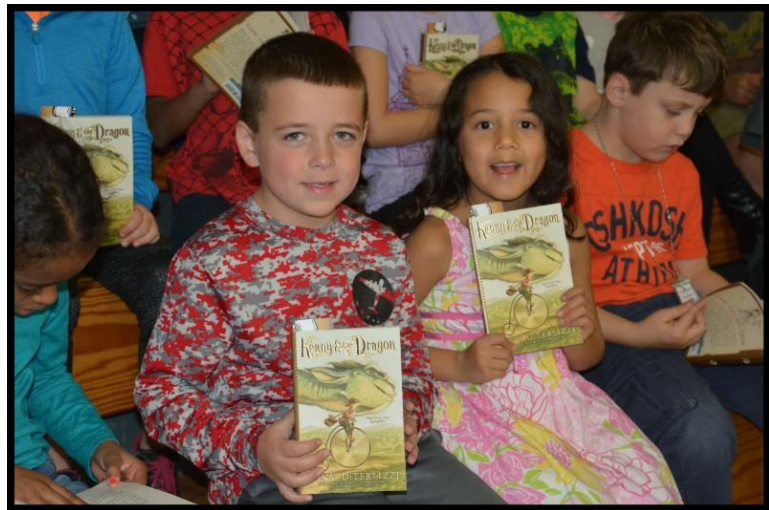

PROBLEM BASED LEARNING

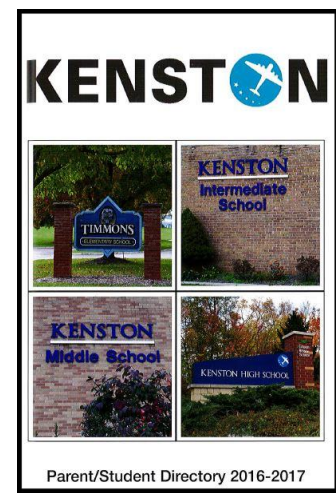
