STATE REPORT CARD: PART II RELEASED

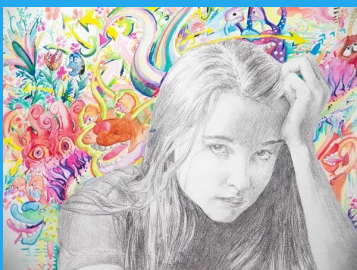
The Ohio Department of Education released the second round of school report card data on February 25th. Information released included

ranking of overall student achievement, annual progress and an area called gap closing, which addresses student success regardless of income, race, ethnicity or disability. [View Kenston report card data.](#)

Information released in January highlighted: K-3 literacy improvement, graduation rates and prepared for success data. Typically, report card information is released at the beginning of the school year but was delayed due transitioning to different assessments.

The State Report Card is a benchmark for schools statewide. It is only one source of information that measures the success of students. At the building and district level, we use this information along with other internal data to continue to improve student instruction.
