Talent Show Requirements

- · Length- 2-5 minutes (average)
- · School Appropriate
- · Either group or solo-you can't do both
- Must be available for all dates
- Only students with a Talent Show form will be allowed to tryout-Pick a form up from Mrs. Bryan or Mrs. Spangler
- Please put music on a CD, jump drive, or email a MP3 so it can be given to KHS.

Suggestions

- Practice! Practice! Practice! We typically have over 50 acts tryout (sometimes more). We usually have 20 or so acts in the show.
- · Be sure you work with people who are willing to practice with you!
- Choose an act that is easily heard and seen
- Be prepared to perform in front of over 500 people

- Some lighting
- Mr. Kenan will help with sound during dress rehearsal

Important Information

- All participants must wear coverings on their feet-socks, shoes, tape.
- If you need equipment not listed on the previous slide, you will need to bring it.
- Accompanionists are allowed for acts.
- You can only be in a group with students in grades 4 and 5.
- Preview your music so that it is appropriate for school.
- If you are singing you <u>must</u> have the karaoke version of your song- no exceptions

Try Out Form


- One form must be filled out by each child wanting to participate in the show (even if you are in a group)

Tryouts

- Tryout times will be given on Tuesday May 7 via student's email.
- Times are based on the type of act you are doing.
- Some tryout times will be during school, and others will be after school
- If you have an after school conflict, you must write it on the Try Out form, but there are no quarantees!
- You should arrive 5 minutes early for your tryout time, ready to perform.
- Tryouts are on Tuesday, May 14th beginning after the last lunch. Some will be in the Innovation Lab, and others will be in the Cafeteria
