While students are only required to read two books of choice, they are highly encouraged to read well beyond that this summer! The final iReady report will also have their Lexile Level which may help in selecting books. Research shows that reading over the summer helps maintain and improve a student's level of reading skills, so please have your child read and immerse him/herself in some books of interest this summer!
